# Investment objective

The Fund aims to track as closely as possible the returns of the MSCI Europe Climate Paris Aligned Index (the Index). The Fund will invest in, or gain exposure to shares of companies which make up the Index. The Fund qualifies under Article 8 of SFDR.



# Investment strategy

The Index is designed to support investors seeking to reduce their exposure to transition and physical climate risks and who wish to pursue opportunities arising from the transition to a lower-carbon economy while aligning with the Paris Agreement requirements. It incorporates the task force on Climate-related Financial Disclosures recommendations and is designed to exceed the minimum standards of the EU Paris-Aligned Benchmark. The Fund is passively managed and aims to invest in the shares of the companies in the same proportion as in the Index. There may be circumstances when it is not possible for the Fund to invest in all constituents of the Index. If the Fund cannot invest directly in the companies that constitute the Index, it may gain exposure by using other investments such as depositary receipts, funds or derivatives. The Fund may invest up to 35% in securities from a single issuer during exceptional market conditions, up to 10% in total return swaps and contracts for difference, and up to 10% in other funds. # Main risks

- The Fund's unit value can go up as well as down, and any capital invested in the Fund may be at risk.
- The value of investible securities can change over time due to a wide variety of factors, including but not limited to: political and economic news, government policy, changes in demographics, cultures and populations, natural or human-caused disasters etc.
- To the extent that the Fund seeks to replicate index performance by holding individual securities, there is no guarantee that its composition or performance will exactly match that of the target index at any given time ("tracking error").






